Dear Parents

I want to share the following information with you:

- On every alternate Tuesday and Thursday there will be hot chocolate for sale at the hostel @ R5-00 per cup. You are welcome to send money if you want your child to participate in this fundraising project.
- Please note that only winter school uniform will be allowed from next week. The uniform consists of:
  - BOYS: Grey long pants, socks, black school shoes, grey long sleeve shirt, jersey and dri-mac.
  - GIRLS: Grey long pants, socks, black school shoes, golf T-shirt, jersey and dri-mac / OR black tights, skirt, black school shoes, jersey and dri-mac.
- Girls are not allowed to wear navy tights or to wear black ski-pants with maroon socks.
- Please note that the track suit is **NOT** part of our uniform and therefore cannot be worn during school. Only children participating in sport wears the tracksuit on the day that they are representing our school.
- Uniform on a Friday: Normal winter uniform OR Friday T-shirt with a blue LONG jean and school jersey / dri-mac. No denim short or knee high denim pants allowed.
- Send warm clothes as it gets very cold at night and early in the morning. Send vests for the children to wear underneath their uniform.
- Make sure that your child has a sheet, duvet and blanket. Children cannot sleep without a sheet. The bedding keeps on sliding off the PVC covered mattresses.
- Please make sure that your child packs his/her tooth brush, toothpaste and toiletries. Each child needs a towel.
- Make sure that your child has a clean mask for EVERYDAY. Either 6 disposable or 6 cloth masks. Pack enough socks for each day.
- Send a black bag or other bag for your child's bedding.
- Encourage your child to adhere to our Covid 19 protocols, wear your mask, keep your social distance and sanitize and wash your hands regularly.
- Please remember parent's day on 14 May from 14:00 – 15:30 and again from 16:30 – 18:00. You are welcome to attend the session that suits you best.
